Deal Music & Arts* aims to raise £20,000 in 2018

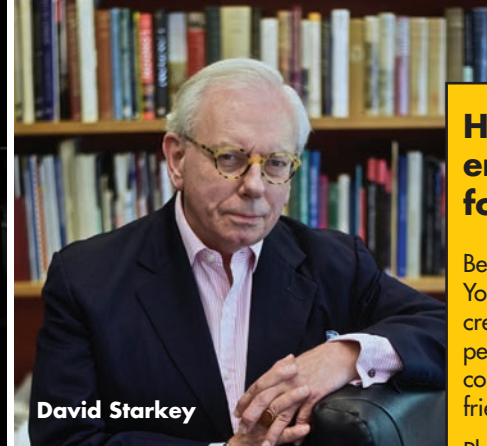
Last year our outreach achieved the following:

- worked with 26 Schools and Universities
- 51 artists and musicians inspiring 1,180 participants aged 3 to 70
- 24% eligible Pupil Premium (families living below the poverty line of £1 per person per day)
- 17% with Special Education Needs and Disabilities and 9% BAME.
- 5 ongoing year-round programmes.
- 70 workshops and 8 performances including Deal Carnival
- 96 Teachers and 26 Carers/parents came to workshops and performances – 86% increase on 2016.
- 44 children in 2 primary schools received Arts Award Discovery Certificates
- Launched online digital resource for Bold As.
