



The Guy and Elinor Meynell Charitable Trust Bursary Fund supporting young people's musical development

Deal Music and Arts is pleased to announce we are working with the Guy and Elinor Meynell Trust Bursary Fund to provide support for young people aged 10 to 18 years who are part of our education projects to help with instrumental tuition. The purpose of our bursaries is not to fund existing weekly lessons. Rather they are intended to facilitate up to 10 x 1:1 lessons for talented musicians who could not otherwise afford them or to provide supplementary tuition (in addition to regular lessons) for accomplished musicians with the aim of introducing the student to a style or genre of music that is not covered in their weekly lessons. You may wish to nominate a tutor, or we can recommend one who specialises in the particular musical style you want to explore.

Applicants must be between the ages of 10- 18 years and be able to demonstrate to us a commitment to learning and to making the most of the support we offer. We will offer support for a course of tuition, up to 10 lessons, and evidence will be required to prove that lessons have been attended, a willingness to explore new ideas shown and to have practised regularly. It is important that parents/carers and instrument teachers support the bursary holder and can send us confirmation in writing or by email.
