

## The Guy and Elinor Meynell Charitable Trust Bursary Fund supporting young people's musical development

Deal Music and Arts is pleased to be working with the Guy and Elinor Meynell Trust Bursary Fund to provide support for young people aged 10 to 18 years who are associated with our education projects to help with instrumental tuition. The purpose of our bursaries is to facilitate initially up to 5 x 1:1 lessons for talented musicians who could not otherwise afford them <u>or</u> to provide supplementary tuition for accomplished musicians with the aim of introducing the student to a style or genre of music that is not covered in their existing weekly lessons. You may wish to nominate a tutor, or we can recommend one who specialises in the particular musical style you want to explore. Young people may also use the funding to attend a masterclass or special music tuition workshop which they would otherwise not be able to attend.

Applicants must be between the ages of 10- 18 years and be able to demonstrate a commitment to learning and to making the most of the support we offer. Evidence of attendance will be required, a willingness to explore new ideas shown and to have practised regularly. It is important that parents/carers and instrument teachers support the bursary holder and can send us confirmation in writing or by email.
